



The yellow line indicates the approximate limits of the original 1893 structure and the 1999 addition.


GPL QUADRUPLED IN SIZE, going from 4,000 to 17,000 square feet!







2024: 36" Wide Aisle – ACCESSIBLE (Vanessa Abraham demonstrates)




